Terms of reference – Drupal Web developer

The Global Partnership for Education (GPE) works with developing countries to ensure that every child receives a quality basic education, prioritizing the poorest, the most vulnerable and those living in countries affected by fragility and conflict. GPE mobilizes financing for education and supports developing countries to build effective education systems founded on evidence-based planning and policies.

GPE is a global fund and a partnership whose members include developing country governments, more than 20 donor nations, multilateral development and humanitarian agencies, as well as organizations from the private sector, philanthropy, civil society and the teaching profession.

The GPE Secretariat of over 80 full-time staff is hosted by the World Bank with headquarters in Washington DC. A constituency-based Board of Directors sets policies and strategies and approves performance-based funding grants to improve learning outcomes and equity through building stronger education systems. In recent years, GPE has disbursed approximately US\$500 million annually.

In the GPE Secretariat, the Partnership and External Relations team (PERT) comprises several sub-teams, including the Communications team, which hosts within it the website team. The web team manages both front and back end of the GPE website (globalpartnership.org) with support from several vendors and consultants.

We are looking for Drupal web developer who can support our day-to-day maintenance of the website. The consultant will work mostly remotely and may be asked to come in for meetings on certain occasions. It is expected that this work will require 2 to 3 days of work per week. The consultant will work under the supervision of the website manager and in close cooperation with the rest of the website team.

The contract will initially be for a period of 3 months (35 days), renewable for a longer term if both parties are satisfied. The contract is expected to run from end of May to August 2017.

Duties and Accountabilities:

- Provide technical support and troubleshoot technical issues
- Identify opportunities for process improvement, planning, and implementing changes
- Provide front end development for interactive features
- Work with the web team and assist in defining requirements for new initiatives
- Use the minimal amount of advanced scripting to ensure 100% accessibility and optimization and to support a modern look-and-feel that fosters usability, high interactivity, and social media integration.
- Develop PHP and Java scripts to support desired web functionalities, and create CSS to further improve the website look and feel.
- Stay up to date with Drupal core and module improvements, and security patches and updates to comply with world Bank security accreditations.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree or above in Computer Science or related field, or equivalent years of experience
- Minimum of 5 years' experience building and maintaining Drupal sites
- Experience with front-end development, HTML5 and CSS3
- Experience in systems administration and server maintenance would be a plus
- Excellent attention to detail
- Ability to work in multi-cultural environment
